Meet Fr. Claude!

I am Rev. Fr. Claude NIKPI, SMA. I am a priest from the Society of African Missions (SMA). I hail from Cote d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast) in West Africa. I was born on June 25th, 1979 in Dabou_ Cote D'Ivoire.

Upon completion of my high school education in 1998, I was admitted into the SMA to begin my discernment and studies to the Priesthood. After 8 years in the seminary during which I had my philosophy studies in Cote D'Ivoire, my theological studies and a year of pastoral experience in Nigeria, studies on the SMA spirituality in Benin Republic, I was ordained Priest on July 15th, 2006 in Cote D'Ivoire.

Being missionary, I was appointed to work in the Northern part of Nigeria in West Africa from 2006 to 2013. In 2013, I was sent to work in Tenafly, NJ- USA. Being I had opportunity to study and graduated from Fordham University in the Bronx- NY. Upon completion of my term in New Jersey in 2016, I was appointed anew to work in Nigeria. On my second appointment to Nigeria, I became Pastor of St. Andrew's Parish in Benin City- Edo State (South-South of Nigeria). Since 2022, I am fully serving in the SMA administration of Nigeria with residence in Abuja.
